 - Multi-cultural education will be encouraged to live harmoniously with people from different ethnicity, language, and culture.
 - Global citizenship/peace education will be emphasized to meet the expectation and to respond to the challenge as an active global member.
 - Eco-friendly education will be endeavored to correspond with environmental pollution and natural destruction.

Value matters in Policy

- Policy is a process of decision making on values, that are competing, contradicting, or conflicting.
- □ Policy is a product of planned and strategic selection.
 - economic growth vs. welfare distribution
 - short-term performance vs. long-term goal investment
 - state-control vs. decentralization, accountability

Value matters the most in Education

- □ Continuous process of selection among competing values
- instrumental value of education vs fundamental value
- short-term plan/outcome vs mid & long-term plan/outcome
- top-down approach vs bottom-up approach
- □ What value to select depends on each country's context: its developmental stage, socio-political condition, and time where it is situated.
